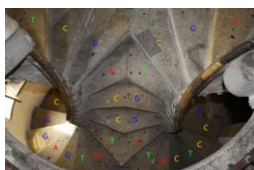

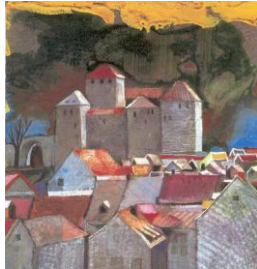



1. The series on **Technology Transfer in Diagnostic Pathology** continued, in 2010 on the topic of „*Dermatopathology*” held in Siófok, Hungary, between 29 April – 1 May, 2010. The faculty members included Argényi Zs, Iványi A, Kárpáti S, Krausz Th, Krenács L, Massone C, Metze D, Orosz Zs, Sápi Z, Tímár J. There were approximately 146 participants, with about 72 delegates from Hungarian and 59 from 17 foreign countries. The handout of the meeting is on its way by air mail.

2. **Slide seminars** for Hungarian pathologist were organized three times this year as well. Each occasion was a one day long event, with the discussion of 10-12 cases in the frame of a course. The number of participants at these seminars was between 100 and 120.

3. **Sponsored Congress Participation**

As in the previous years, participation at the Symposium of the German Division in Bonn was sponsored by the Division, with again 8 Hungarian pathologists taking part in 2010. Furthermore, 25 participants were also sponsored at the 5th series of *Technology Transfer in Diagnostic Pathology* meeting held in Siófok.

The **Pannonia Congress of Pathology** was held in Graz, Austria, between March 3-6, 2010, coorganized with the National Pathology Societies and IAP Divisions of Austria, Croatia, Hungary and Slovenia. Detailed information will be given by Professor Hans Popper, the organizer of the meeting.

4. **Future plans**

- The **6th Central European Regional Meeting - Technology Transfer in Diagnostic Pathology** will be held in Balatonfüred, Hungary, between April 7-9, 2011, organized by DeMay RM, Kocjan G, Krausz Th, Syrjänen K, Schmitt F, Vass L and Vielh Ph on the topic of „*Cytopathology*”. The number of expected participants is to be around 200. The website of the event is www.kmcongress.com.
