REQUEST FOR FINANCIAL SUPPORT

1. The Anglophone West African Division of the International Academy of Pathology (AWADIAP) will be very grateful for your financial support towards hosting its Second Annual Scientific Conference at University College Hospital (UCH) Ibadan , Nigeria between June 24-30, 2007. (awadiap.org)
2. AWADIAP was inaugurated in July 2005 and was ratified at the recent IAP Centennial Celebration in Montreal September 2006.
3. In 2005, AWADIAP organized a Scientific Conference on Diagnostic Cytopathology at UCH.in August 2006. The Faculty consisted of 6 members of *Friends of Africa-USCAP Initiative* led by Dr Fred Silva, The Executive Vice President of USCAP.

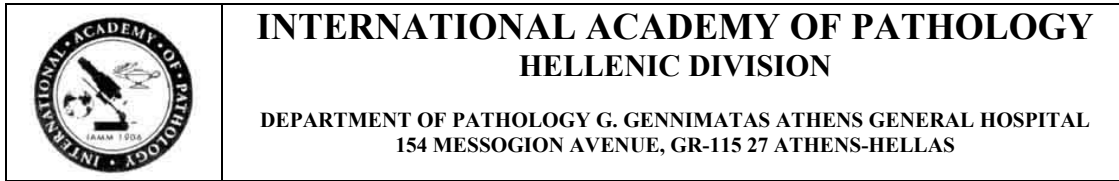
